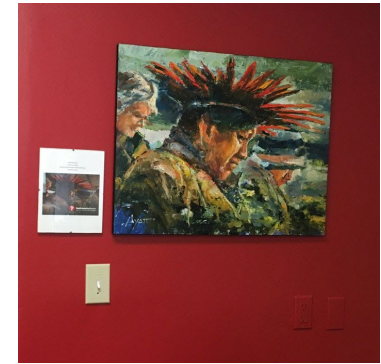
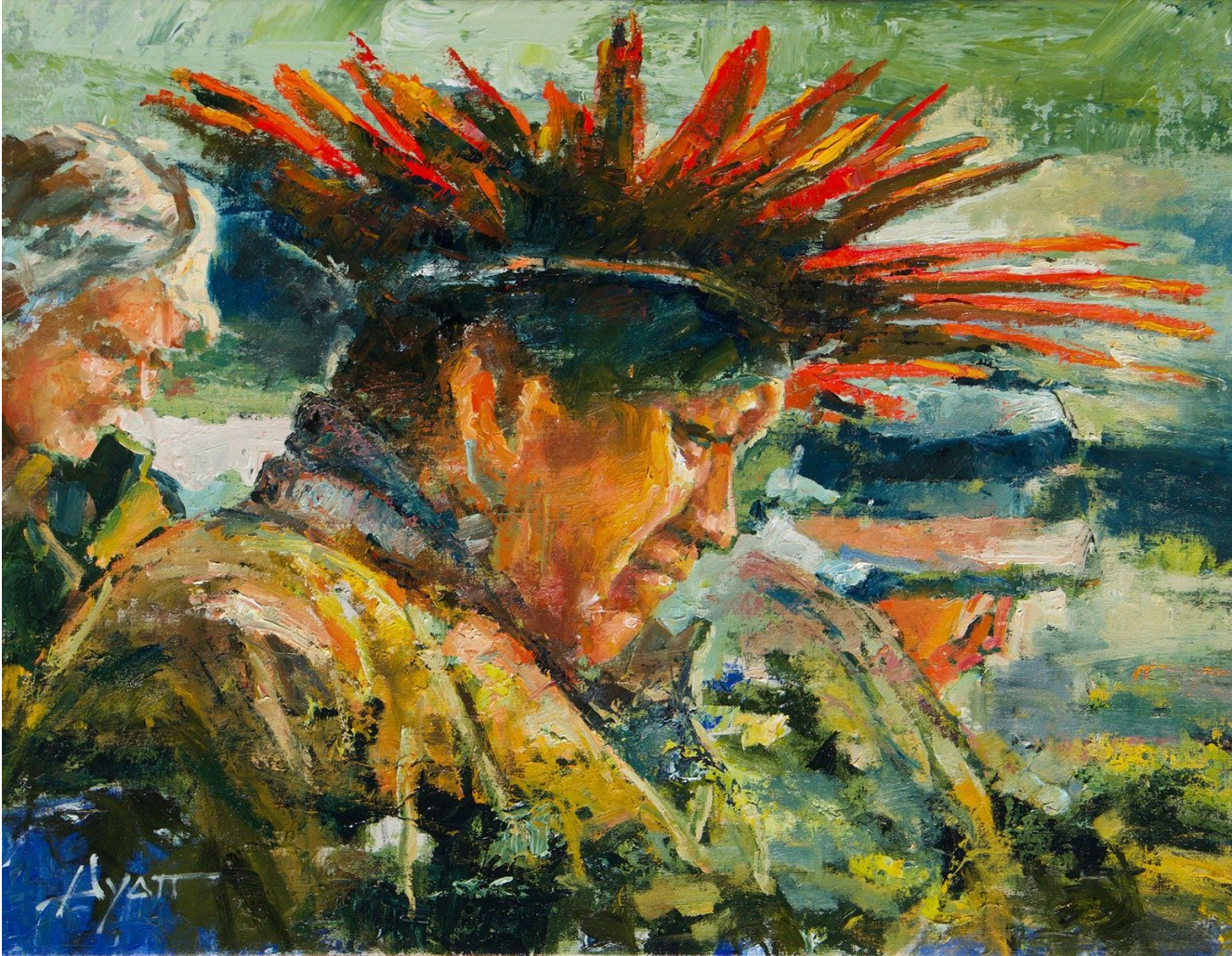

## South America Mission Fort Mill, South Carolina



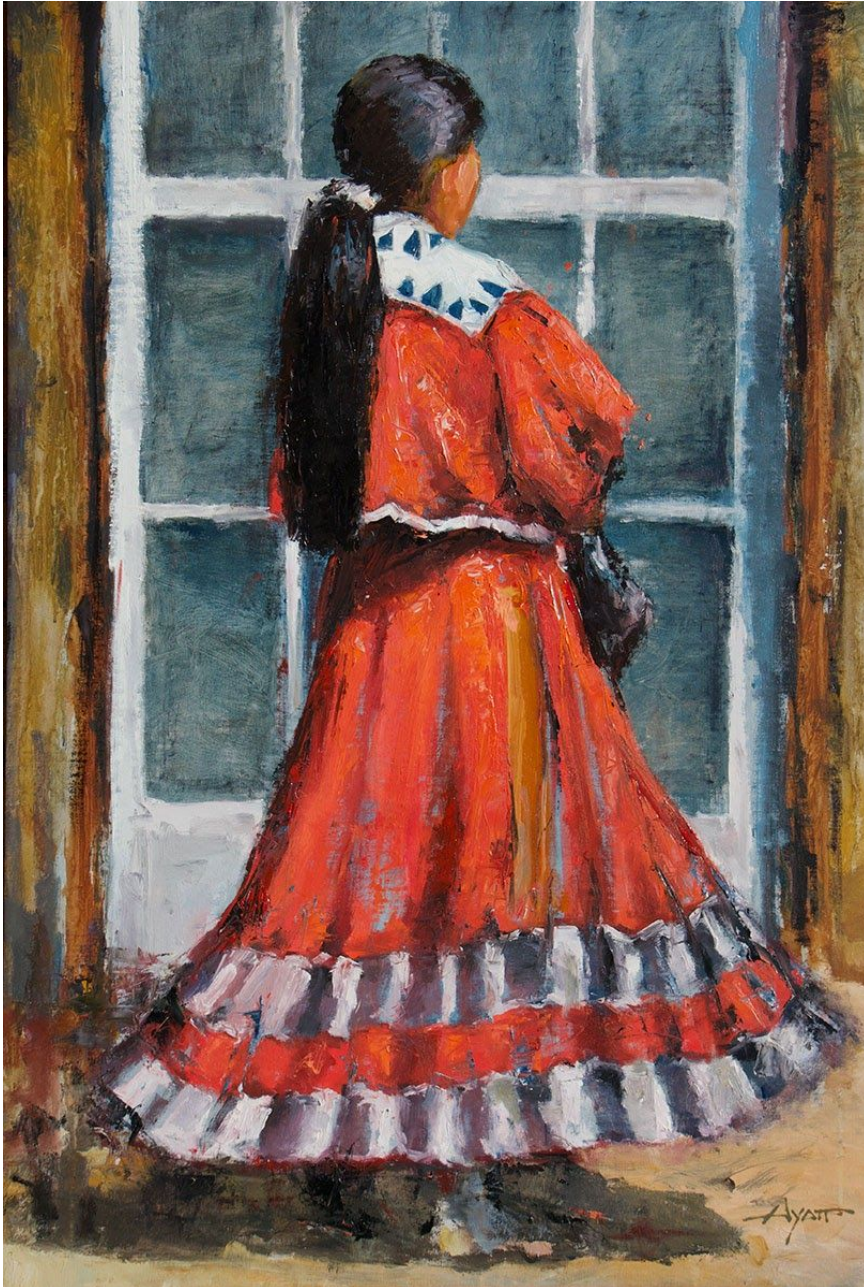
### ***Brazil Prayer Meeting***

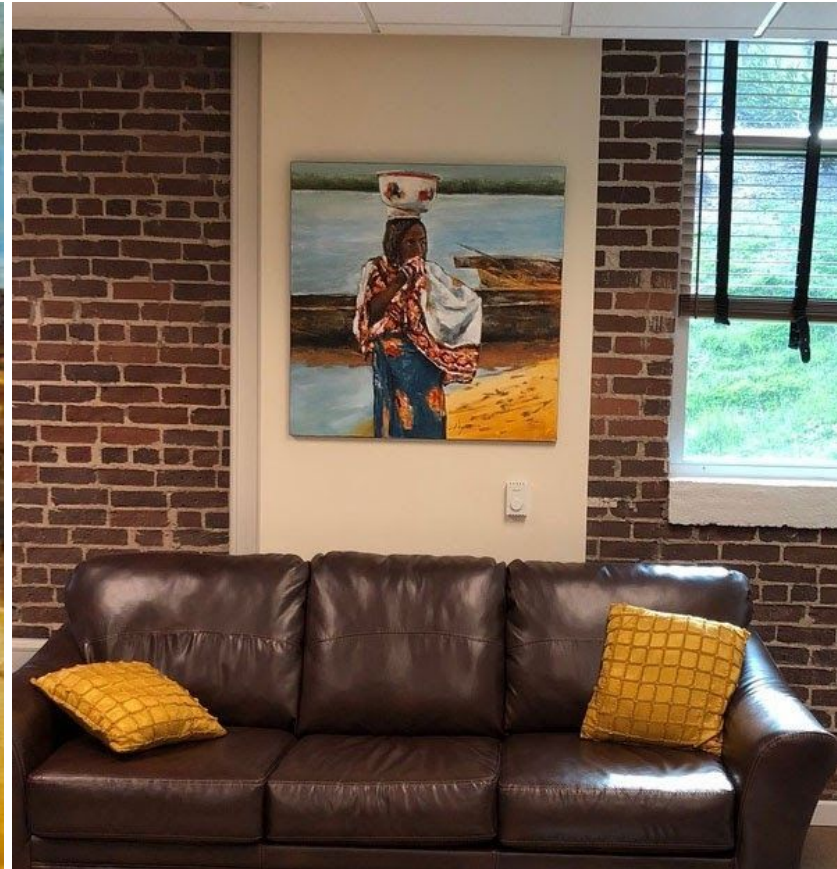

World Thrust International exists to help pastors, through seminars, lead their congregations into becoming fully engaged in making the message of God's great salvation available to all people.

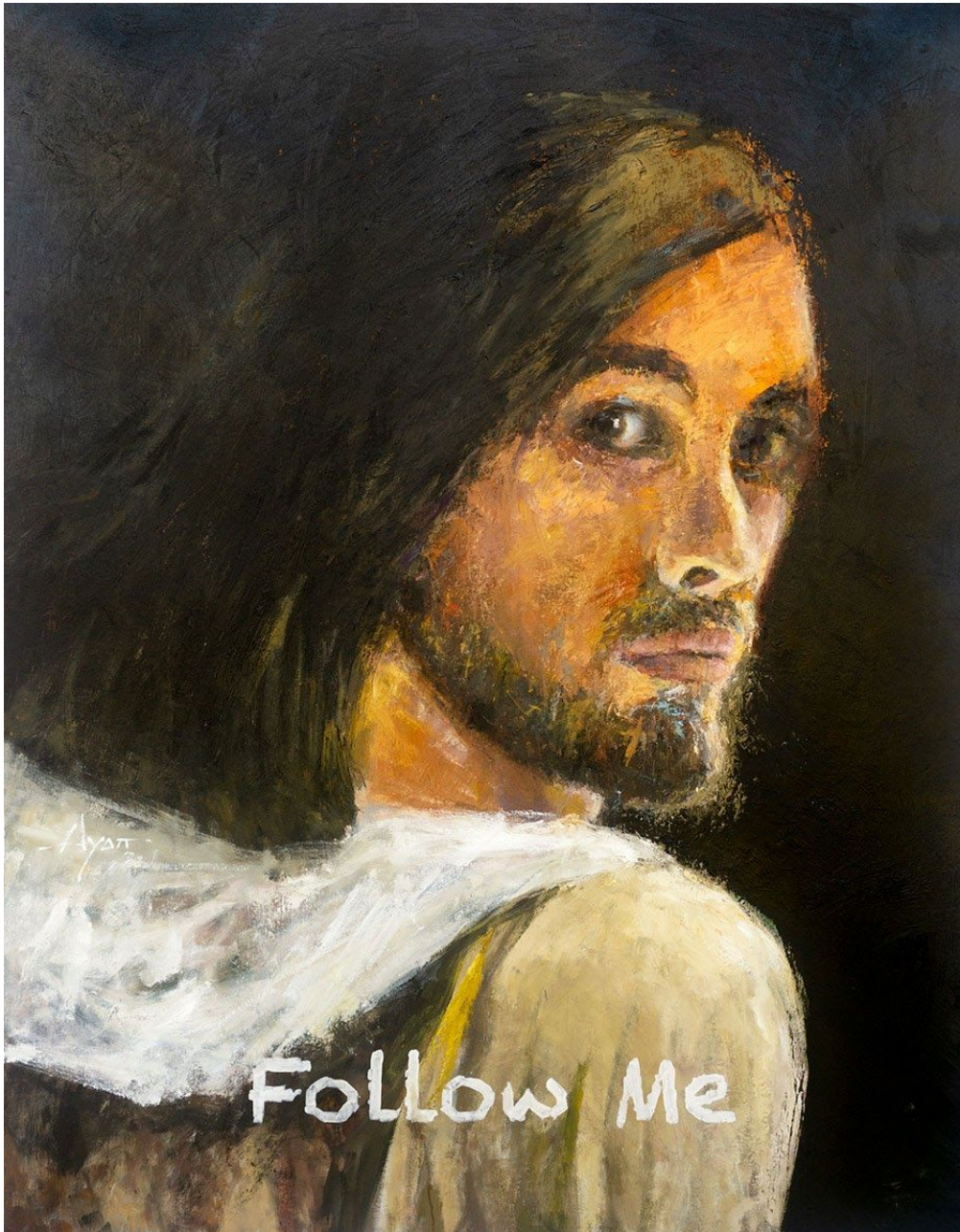

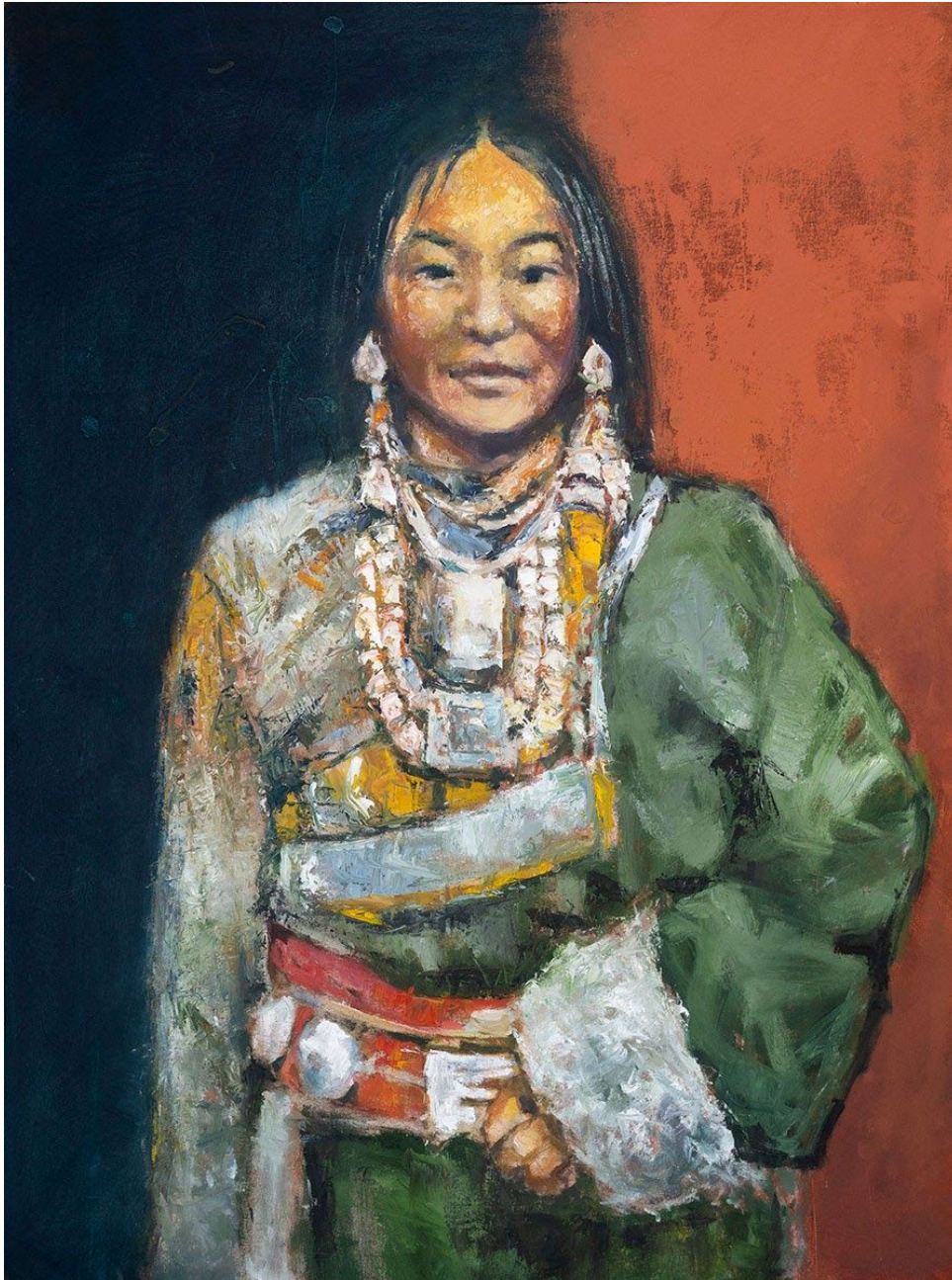

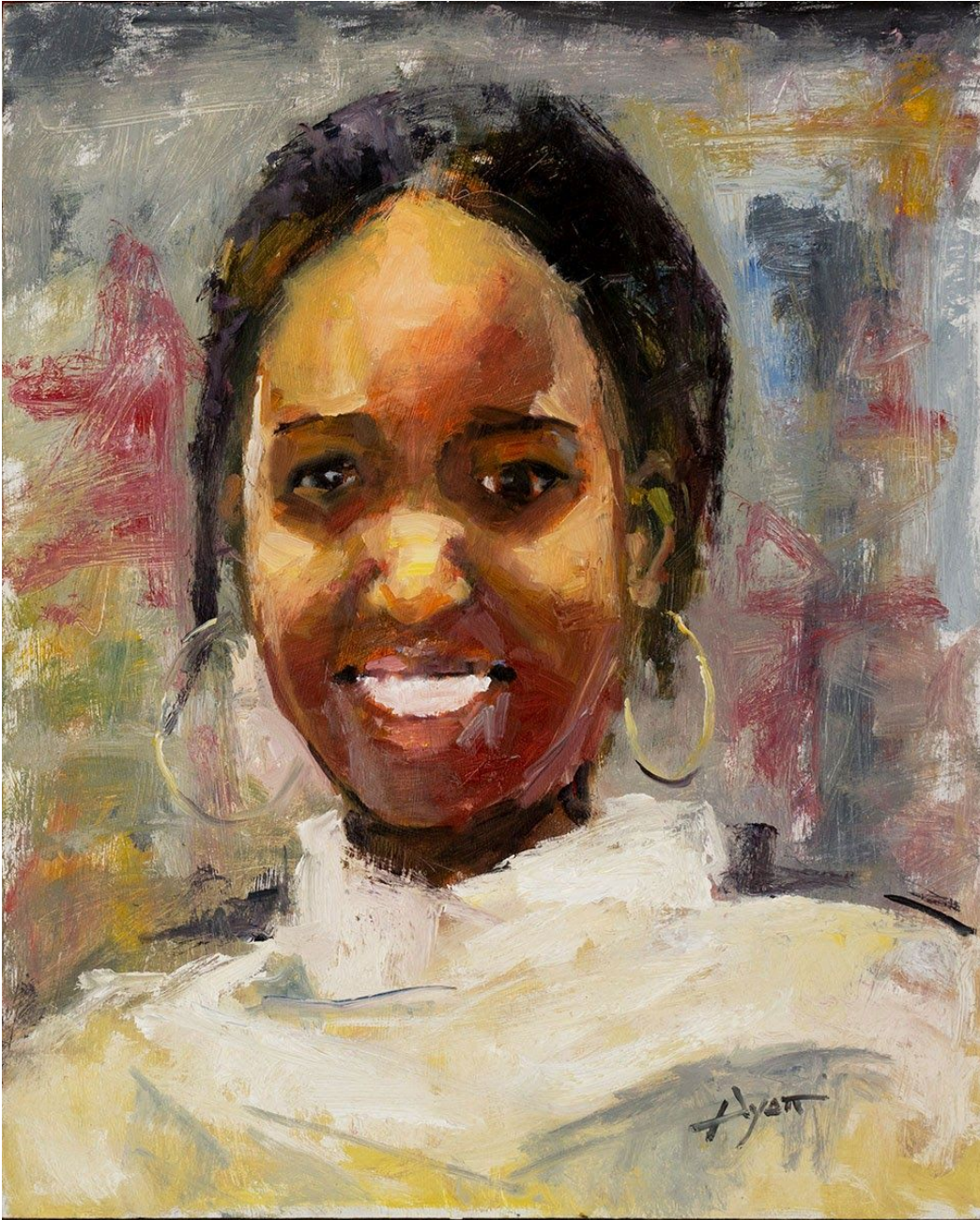

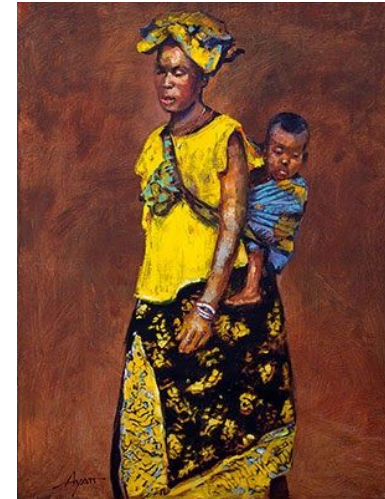
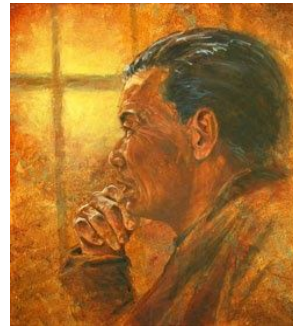

A community of Christians who come together to support persecuted believers in more than 60 countries.

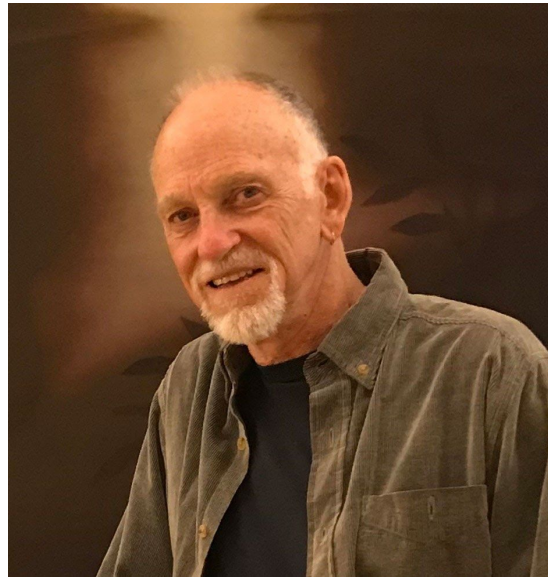
